Description	The Pacific Islands Climate Change Virtual Library provides access to web-based climate change tools including case studies, guidebooks, and methodologies for assessing vulnerabilities. This website is used by Pacific Island communities looking to implement climate change adaptation plans. The site was developed in cooperation with the NOAA/National Oceanographic Data Center (NODC), Pacific Climate Information System (PaCIS), coastal managers in American Samoa and Samoa, International Pacific Research Center's (IPRC) Asia Pacific Data Research Center (APDRC) at University of Hawaii School of Ocean and Earth Science and Technology (UH/SOEST), Pacific Islands Global Climate Observing System (PI-GCOS) program, and other partners in the Pacific Islands.
