Description	The Joint Institute for Marine and Atmospheric Research was created in 1977 by an agreement between the Environmental Research Laboratories (ERL) of NOAA and the University of Hawaii at Manoa. JIMAR was established to pursue the common research interests of NOAA and the UH in oceanic, atmospheric, and geophysical research. Major areas of research in JIMAR include climate and global change, equatorial oceanography, tsunamis, and fisheries oceanography.
